4. Due to the fact that there is minimal research supporting the clinical efficacy of Animal Chiropractic, some aspects of your animal's care may be used in future data.

5. Dr. Bailey will explain the scope of his care, and describe the procedures he will perform on your animal. The American Veterinary Medical Association's description of Animal Chiropractic as follows; "Veterinary chiropractic is the examination, diagnosis, and treatment of non-human animals through manipulation and adjustments of specific joints and cranial structures... Veterinary chiropractic does NOT include dispensing medication, performing surgery, injecting medication, or replacing traditional care."
